

In 2004, a group of determined Catholic parents, clergy and educators gathered to find a way to assist their parish elementary schools to develop inclusion programs for their children with developmental and/or intellectual disabilities. Their children with disabilities attended separate "special" schools, so these visionary organizers sought to put an end to the painful experiences of families whose children could not go to school each morning with their siblings and peers.

The result was the formation of the Catholic Coalition for Special Education (CCSE). There is no other nonprofit organization in the Mid-Atlantic region dedicated to supporting Catholic schools in creating and expanding services and inclusive programs for children with disabilities. CCSE's mission is to ensure that children with special needs are able to attend and receive an appropriate high-quality education in local Catholic elementary and high schools. CCSE's mission is fully endorsed by the Archdiocese of Washington and Archdiocese of Baltimore.



Today, our mission is being fulfilled through the following programs:

CCSE's "Believe in Me!" Programs offer advocacy and support for the creation of special education programs in Catholic schools in Washington, DC and Maryland through seed funding, technical assistance and professional development, to enable schools to accommodate students with intellectual disabilities.

CCSE's Technical Assistance and Training ensures that schools are properly equipped and staffed to meet the needs of students with disabilities and that teachers are well prepared to serve all the students in their classrooms. Services range from individual teacher coaching and topical workshops to year-long capacity building assistance tailored specifically to a school's needs.

CCSE offers training workshops and professional development opportunities for Catholic school educators and administrators. This includes **CCSE's Tuition Assistance Grants for Advanced Degrees in Special Education.**

CCSE's Family Support helps families navigate the frequently complex maze of services by providing current information on school programs and community resources. It also provides spiritual and practical support for parents on the journey to raising a child with a disability and provides social and networking opportunities such as our Holy Hour/Happy Hour.



Support our Mission

CCSE has no full-time staff and performs much of its work on a volunteer or pro-bono basis. All we offer to schools is free of charge, but not free of cost. We count on the generosity of individual donors, foundation grants and fundraising events to fund our programs. Please help CCSE respond to the record number of requests for assistance received this year from our Catholic schools by supporting our Golf Classic.

CCSE has reached over 6,000 students, teachers and families; awarded 68 grants totaling over \$1,000,000; awarded grants to 30 Catholic schools in eight Maryland counties; and awarded CCSE Tuition Assistance for Advanced Study in Special Education grants to two special education teachers.
